TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

CHAPEL STREET and CHURCH STREET, EARL SHILTON

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A road closure is required on Church Street from Hill Top to Chapel Street and Chapel Street at the junction with Church Street on the 21st September 2020 for 3 days. The hours of work will be between 09:00 and 15:00. The roads will be clear outside of these times.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Leicestershire County Council** to facilitate carriageway patching and any other associated work to the highway.

The proposed alternative diversion route for Chapel Street will be via: Almeys Lane, High Street, Hill Top, Earl Shilton and vice versa.

The proposed alternative diversion route for Church Street will be via: Leicester Road, Earl Shilton; Leicester Road, Desford Road, Main Street and Church Street, Earl Shilton Road, Thurlaston; Thurlaston Lane, Earl Shilton and vice versa.
